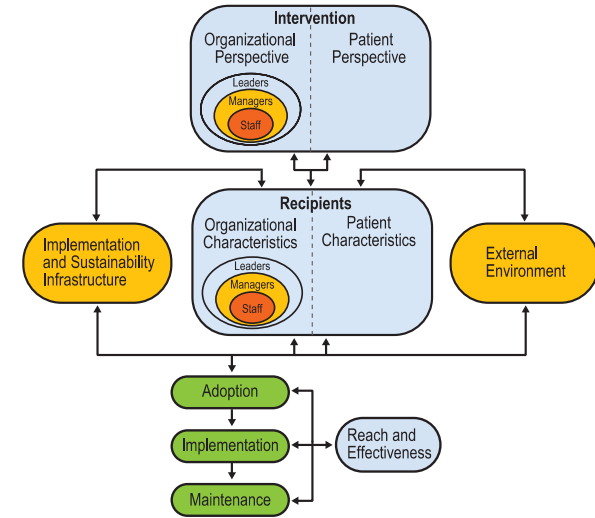

# iPRISM Webtool: Iterative Practical, Robust Implementation and Sustainability Model Webtool

- Simplifies implementation science
  - Using PRISM
- Guides and prompts users to **iteratively**
  - Assess and align with context
  - Assess progress on key outcomes
  - Develop feasible and impactful strategies/adaptations
  - Create action plans
- Systematic, consistent approach

  - With and without implementation science expertise

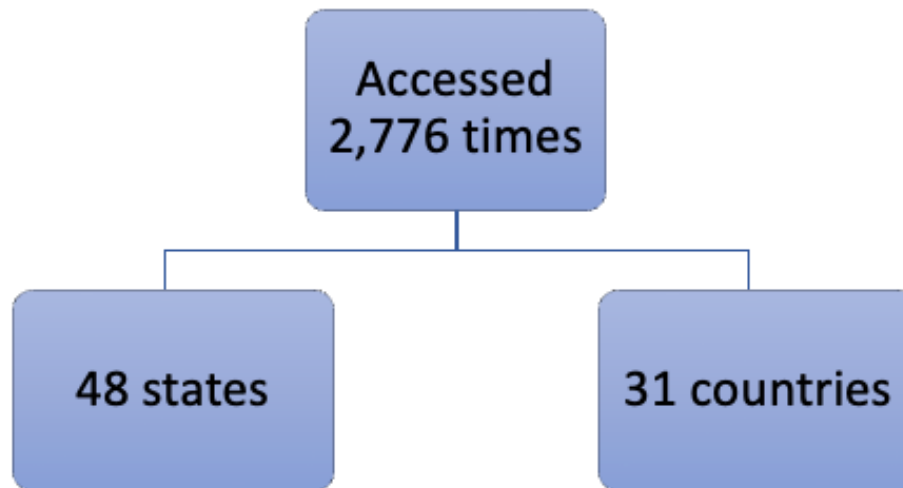
